If it fails we replace it at no charge. You cover shipping only.

Free Electronic Shul Bulletin Board

Exact zmanim, the Hebrew date, the parsha and your own announcements — on a screen that updates itself, every day, with nobody reprinting a sign.

WHY SHULS PUT ONE UP

A printed zmanim sheet is out of date within days. Someone has to reprint it and re-tape it — and the people who most need it, visitors and guests, are the ones reading the wrong time.

This replaces that sheet permanently.



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MAIN CHARACTERISTICS

Right for your building, not your city

Halachic times are calculated from your shul's **precise geographic coordinates** and your own time zone — not an approximation for the nearest city or zip code. They refresh continuously, and each shul decides which times it wants displayed.

- ✓ **Atomic-clock precision.** Synchronized to the second, so every minyan begins exactly when it says it does.
- ✓ **Hebrew calendar.** Hebrew date, the weekly parsha, and Shabbat start and end times.
- ✓ **Sefirat HaOmer.** The day's count, its kabbalistic attribute in Hebrew and English, and the bracha.
- ✓ **Hayom Yom and daily study.** Rotating Torah inspiration between community updates.
- ✓ **Local information** relevant to your geographic area, and the local weather.
- ✓ **Several ready-made templates** — choose the one that suits your lobby.

The Omer count appears on its own, in Hebrew and English, from the second night of Pesach through Shavuot.

WHAT IS ON THE SCREEN

Five zones, one glance

Left	Zmanim and the atomic clock, in your shul's time zone. Each shul chooses what to show.
Top	Hebrew calendar — date, parsha, Shabbat times.
Center	Institutional information relevant to your area.
Right	Your congregation's own announcements, posted by your team.
Bottom	Kosher advertising, drawn only from the Jewish community in your area.

YOUR OWN ANNOUNCEMENTS

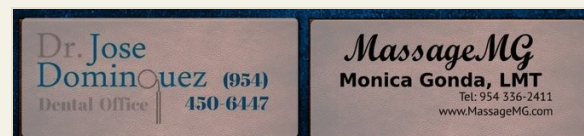
Everything in the right-hand zone is yours, posted and changed by your own staff at any time:

- ✓ Events and programs, with text and photos
- ✓ Class and shiur times
- ✓ Birthdays and anniversaries

ADVERTISING, STATED PLAINLY

The strip at the bottom is what makes the ongoing service free. Every advertiser is kosher and from the Jewish community in your own geographic area — the local kosher market or the local mohel, not a national brand.

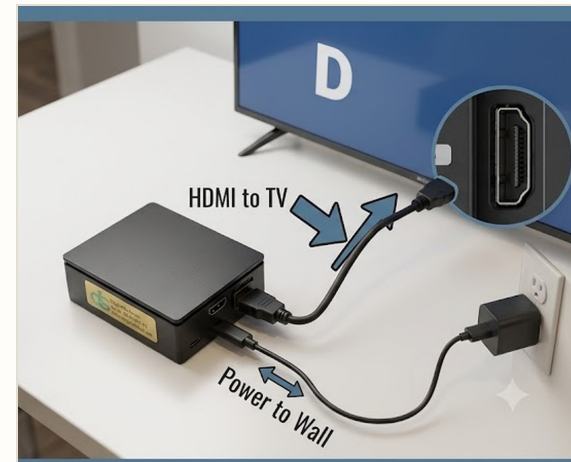
Every subscriber manages and modifies all customization options at any time through our multilanguage web dashboard. A mobile app is in development.
