

Everything on the Screen, Explained

This is one real DigitalShul display, exactly as a shul sees it. Every field updates itself — nobody edits a time, a date or a count by hand.

The display shows the following information:

- 1** Atomic clock and civil date: 11:44⁰² AM, Sun, May 3
- 2** Zmanim: Shema : 9:58 am
- 3** Tehilim: Chs 79-82
- 4** Shabbat: Start: 7:38 pm, Ends: 8:35 pm
- 5** Hebrew date and parsha: Iyar 16, 5786, Behar-Bechukotai
- 6** Sefirat HaOmer and daily study: 31st day of the Omer, 16 Iyyar 5786, Today is 31 days, which are 4 weeks and 3 days of the Omer, Tiferet sheb'Hod תפארת שבִּהוד, Beauty within Splendor
- 7** Your own schedule and announcements: Shabbat YIC (Friday Night 6:25 pm, Shacharis 9:30 am, Kiddush approx. 12:00 pm, 2 Class from 6:15 pm, Mincha-Maariv 7:15 pm), Weekday (Shacharis 8:00 am, Talmud Class 7:10 pm, Mincha-Maariv 7:45 pm), Sunday (Tanya 9:15 am)
- 8** Local weather: 75°, Today Mon Tue, 83° 81° 82°, 73° 71° 73°
- 9** Community advertising: Dr. Jose Domínguez (954) 450-6447, Dental Office; MassageMG Monica Gonda, LMT, Tel: 954 336-2411, www.MassageMG.com

Every shul chooses which of these fields it wants displayed, and which zmanim to show.

- 1 Atomic clock and civil date.** Synchronized to the second, in your own time zone.
- 2 Zmanim.** Shema, Plag, Shkia, Maariv and candle lighting, from your shul's exact coordinates — not an approximation for the nearest city.
- 3 Tehilim of the day.** The chapters for today's date in the monthly cycle.
- 4 Shabbat start and end times,** for your building.
- 5 Hebrew date and parsha,** updated at nightfall.
- 6 Sefirat HaOmer and daily study.** The count in words, its kabbalistic attribute in Hebrew and English, and rotating Torah inspiration.
- 7 Your own schedule and announcements.** Shabbat, weekday and Sunday times, classes, events, birthdays and yahrzeits — posted by your staff.
- 8 Local weather,** today and the next two days.
- 9 Community advertising.** Kosher advertisers from your own area. This strip is what makes the service free.
